



On face value, what Caiaphas said simply seems like a wise thing to say, why is it actually so remarkable?

(If you are at house group, split into 2-3s)

What are the amazing consequences for us that Jesus died?

Take a moment to pray and thank Jesus that He died instead of us “the people” that we need not “perish” (Paraphrased from verse 50)

John tells us that it was ‘almost time for the Jewish Passover’

You may have heard ‘Jesus is our passover lamb’, but what does it mean? If you have time, you could flick to Exodus 12:1-14.

Pick up on some of the irony in this passage in John. (There’s a lot!)

How does this passage demonstrate God’s much ‘higher plan’?

(Think of the ending of detective TV program where you finally get to see how all the pieces amazingly fit together)
